$$4 \times 6 = 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 24$$


$$2.4 \times 3 = 4 + 4 + 4 = 12$$


Get the quotient of the following expressions by repeatedly subtracting 4 until it gets to 0:


$$4.32 \div 4 = 32 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 = 0 = 8$$


Answer the following word problems:
