Get the product of the following expressions by repeatedly adding 4:

1. $4 \times 6 = 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 + 4 = 24$

2. $4 \times 3 = 4 + 4 + 4 = 12$

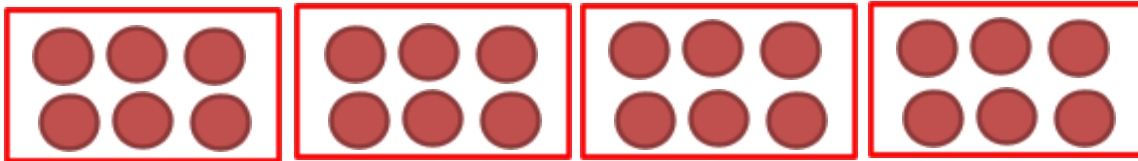
Get the quotient of the following expressions by repeatedly subtracting 4 until it gets to 0:

3. $44 \div 4 = 44 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 = 0 = 11$

4. $32 \div 4 = 32 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4 = 0 = 8$

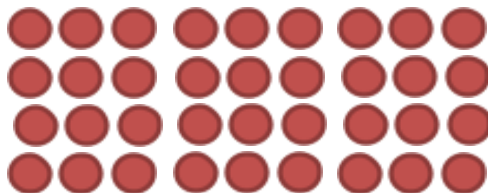
Answer the following word problems:

5. There are 6 folders on a table. How many folders are on 4 tables? Draw equal groups.



$4 \times 6 = 24$ folders

6. There are 48 books on a shelf. How many books are in each row if there are 4 rows? Draw an array model.



$48 \div 4 = 12$ books
